The Cuban regime is attempting to frame solar energy as an alternative to tackle the energy crisis, now with the installation of "solineras" designed to charge tricycles, scooters, and electric cars in the country. Cuba is installing charging stations for electric vehicles as part of its energy strategy, although it faces limitations due to a lack of batteries and dependence on foreign technology. This feature delves into the technological advancements and challenges faced in this transition. The project, led by state-owned Cimex, will roll out in four stages of 10 stations each.

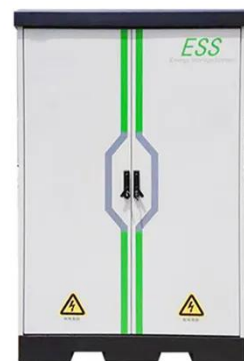
