

Cuba purchases new solar panel manufacturer



Overview

Hangzhou Duojia Technology is registered with the Cuban Chamber of Commerce as an importer of “fabrics and hides, hardware, and automobile parts and pieces,” but since 2024 its operations have also extended to new energy generation technologies, particularly photovoltaics. 

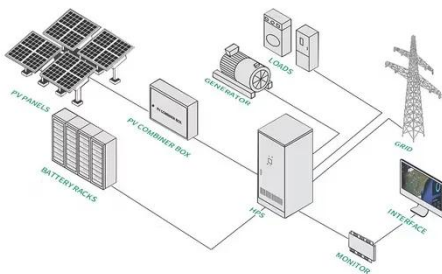
