

# Electricity policy bangkok



## Overview

---

On April 15, the Thai Cabinet approved a proposal to reduce electricity prices from 4.15 baht per kilowatt hour to 3. The decision aims to alleviate the financial burden on households and businesses amid rising. Proposal to lower power bills for May to August period receives cabinet approval, pending Energy Regulatory Commission finalization. 99 baht for the billing period spanning May. The National Energy Policy Council (NEPC) has approved the electricity tariff for the September-December 2025 period, capping the rate at 3. Finance Minister Pichai Chunhavajira stated that Tuesday's meeting was chaired by Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra. At the same time, the three electricity authorities—EGAT, MEA, and PEA—are preparing to invest in infrastructure to accommodate the growing share of renewable energy in the future. 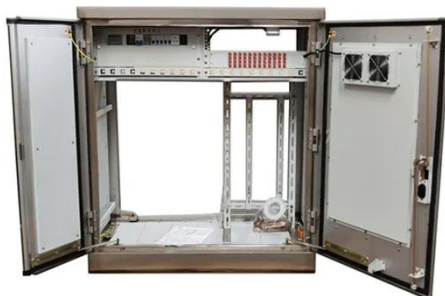

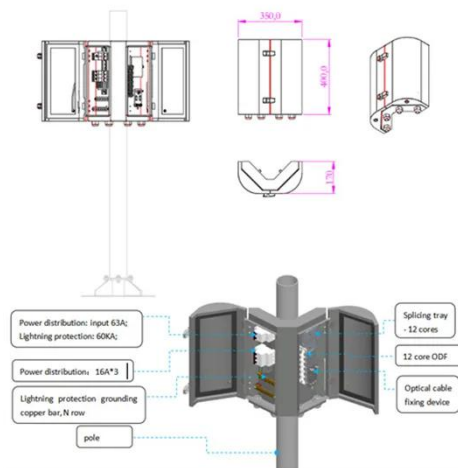
