Overview

Teach everyone the PASS method: Pull the pin, Aim low, Squeeze the handle, Sweep side to side. A transfer switch safely connects your generator to your home's electrical panel, eliminating the need for extension cords snaking through windows. "Generators offer a great way to supply power to your home during power outages or blackouts so you can run fans, heating, lights, and more. But there are some things to be mindful of," says Dan Mock, vice president of operations at Mister Sparky. Be prepared by knowing what you can and cannot do. Keeping your generator running during storms provides several advantages: The continuity of power during severe weather significantly enhances safety and comfort. During severe weather, maintaining power to sump pumps, refrigeration for medications, and communications equipment can be life-critical. To run a generator while it is raining, it must be covered. You can also build your own enclosure.
